(1) Disaster and Health Risk Management for Liveable City

- Face to face summer program at Kyoto University
- **Opportunities:** 14 days summer school to learn disaster prevention and mitigation in Japan to enhance disaster resilience including a practical experience of **one-week internship**
- **Core period:** **August 30 – September 11, 2021**
- **Contents:** **1) Face to face summer school at Kyoto Univ.** (lecture and group discussion), **2) One-week internship at private company** in Japan

- Online summer school with ASEAN collaborative universities
- **Opportunities:** To learn disaster prevention and mitigation in ASEAN countries to enhance disaster resilience and way of living for increasing resilience in disasters in Asia and the Pacific
- **Core period:** **August 2 – 9, 2021**
- **Contents:** **Online summer school** (lectures by ASEAN universities and Kyoto University, group discussion, virtual field trip)

- Opportunities: To learn disaster prevention and mitigation in Japan from the perspective of science, technology and policy to enhance disaster resilience, and **practical experience through internship**
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 - ✓ Online preparation seminar in July organized by Kyoto University
 - ✓ Face to face summer school at Kyoto University (lecture, group discussion and one-week internship at private company)
- Target students: Highly motivated graduate school students at Kyoto University
- Number of participants: Maximum 20 students

(2) Online summer program (Sending out Japanese students)

- Opportunities: To learn disaster prevention and mitigation in ASEAN countries from the perspective of science, technology and policy to enhance disaster resilience, and way of for increasing resilience in disasters in Asia and the Pacific
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 - ✓ Online preparation seminar in July organized by Kyoto University
 - ✓ Online lectures by ASEAN collaborative universities and Kyoto University
 - ✓ Online group discussion and virtual field trip to construction site (dam construction, river improvement, highway construction)
- Number of participants: Maximum 40 students (ASEAN universities 20, Kyoto Univ 20). Kyoto Univ graduate students should take the program together with the program (1).
